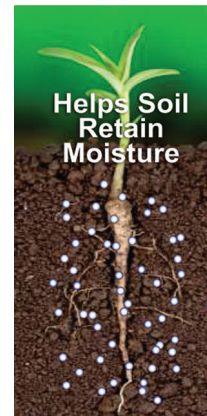


## Medium Sized Water Absorbing Gel Granules

### Used as a mix amendment to reduce watering

Horta-Sorb<sup>®</sup> water management gel polymers are substances that absorb hundreds of times their weight in water. The water absorbed is nearly all available to the plants. This results in reducing watering maintenance and provides a more constant supply of water to the roots.



### Used as a mix amendment to reduce watering

#### APPLICATION

**Transplanting:** Sprinkle 1/2-3 cups of gels into back fill soil close to root system.

**Flower Beds** Broadcast Horta-Sorb<sup>®</sup> at the rate of 1 lb. per 100 sq. ft. and work into the ground 3-4 inches.

**Turf / Soil Amendment:** Broadcast Horta-Sorb<sup>®</sup> at the rate of 3 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. With sprigging and seeding, work into the first 1" of soil with a till or by chain drag dressing at this rate for every 2 inches of soil depth, i.e., you could apply 3X the normal rate if the 9 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. was incorporated in six inches.

**Sod,** lay sod on top of treated area without the need for tilling at the 3 lb. per 1,000 sq. ft. rate.
